




Attitudes of Europeans towards **Air Quality**

Related health and environmental consequences which **are considered serious issues**:




Over two thirds of Europeans aware of the EU air quality standards think they are not adequate and **should be strengthened**

Have you heard of the EU air quality standards?




Do you believe that the existing EU air quality standards are adequate or not?






In all but five Member States, more than half of the respondents think the EU Air Quality Standards should be strengthened
